Download everything offline

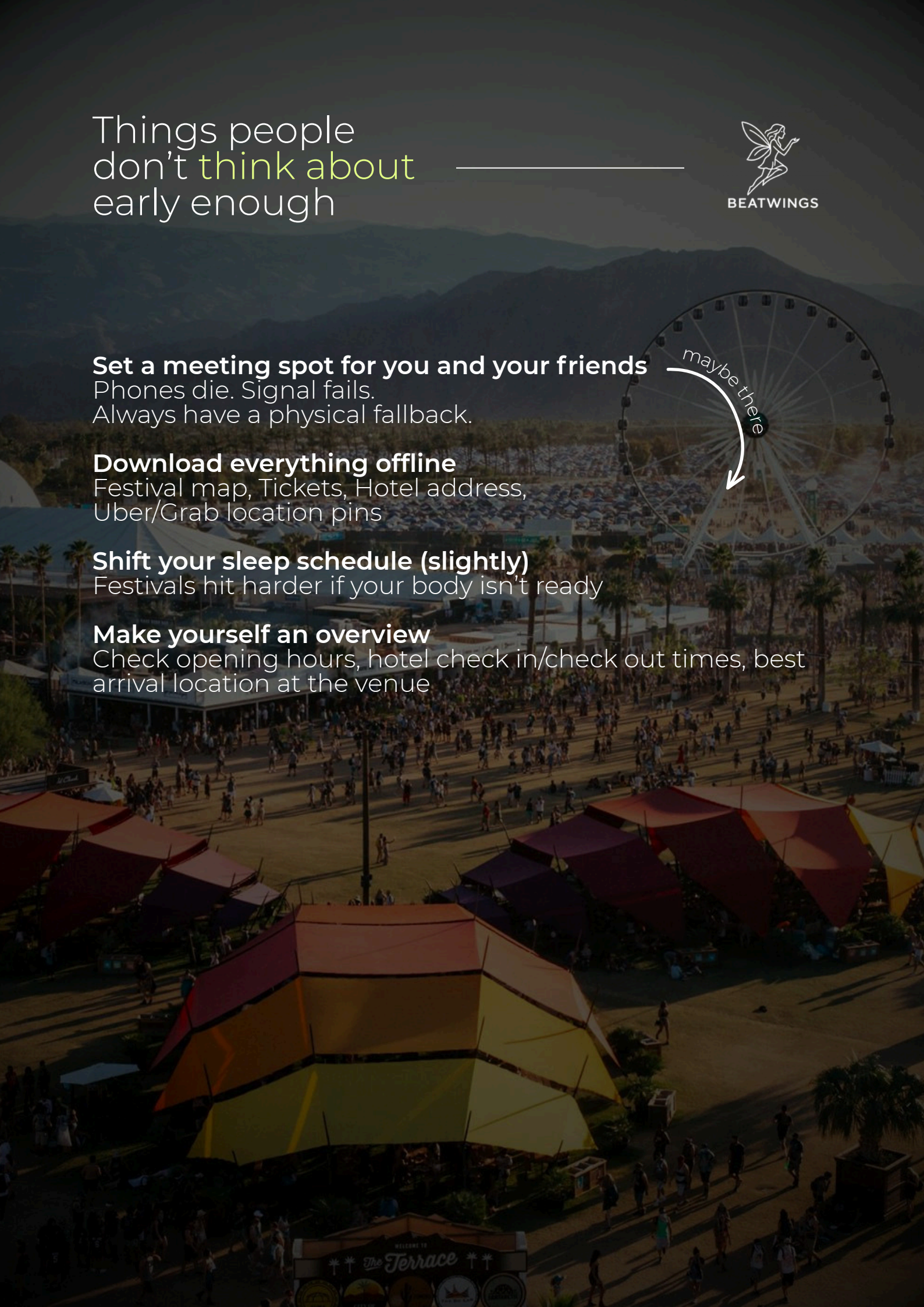
Festival map, Tickets, Hotel address,

Essentials

- Festival ticket

- Swimwear (for pool / water festivals)
- Extra outfit (in case you get wet or sweaty)
- Underwear & socks

Toiletries & Care

- Sunscreen
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Wet wipes
- Hand sanitizer
- Lip balm
- Basic meds (headache, stomach, etc.)
- Menstrual Products

Phone & Content Reality

Don't film everything
You'll remember less

Pick your "capture moments"
2-3 key videos > 100 random clips

Lower screen brightness + airplane mode at times
Battery lasts WAY longer

Energy Management

Don't go 100% on Day 1
Pace yourself. The best moments come later

Alternate drinks with water
Simple, but most people ignore it

Know your 'reset moments'
Chill areas, sitting zones, food breaks

Eat BEFORE you're starving
Festival hunger hits suddenly

FAQ

How do I get my ticket?

We'll provide you your treasure case onsite.

How do festival transfers work?

Our shuttles take you from the hotel to the festival and back (if you want) Easy, safe, and coordinated for the full group.

Do I need a VISA?

If you are a EU-Schengen citizen, US, Canada or Australia you are allowed into Thailand without a visa. 60 days with the possibility of extending for 30 more. (90 in total)

All travelers must fill out The Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC) within three days of landing. Free of Charge (tdac.immigration.go.th)
